

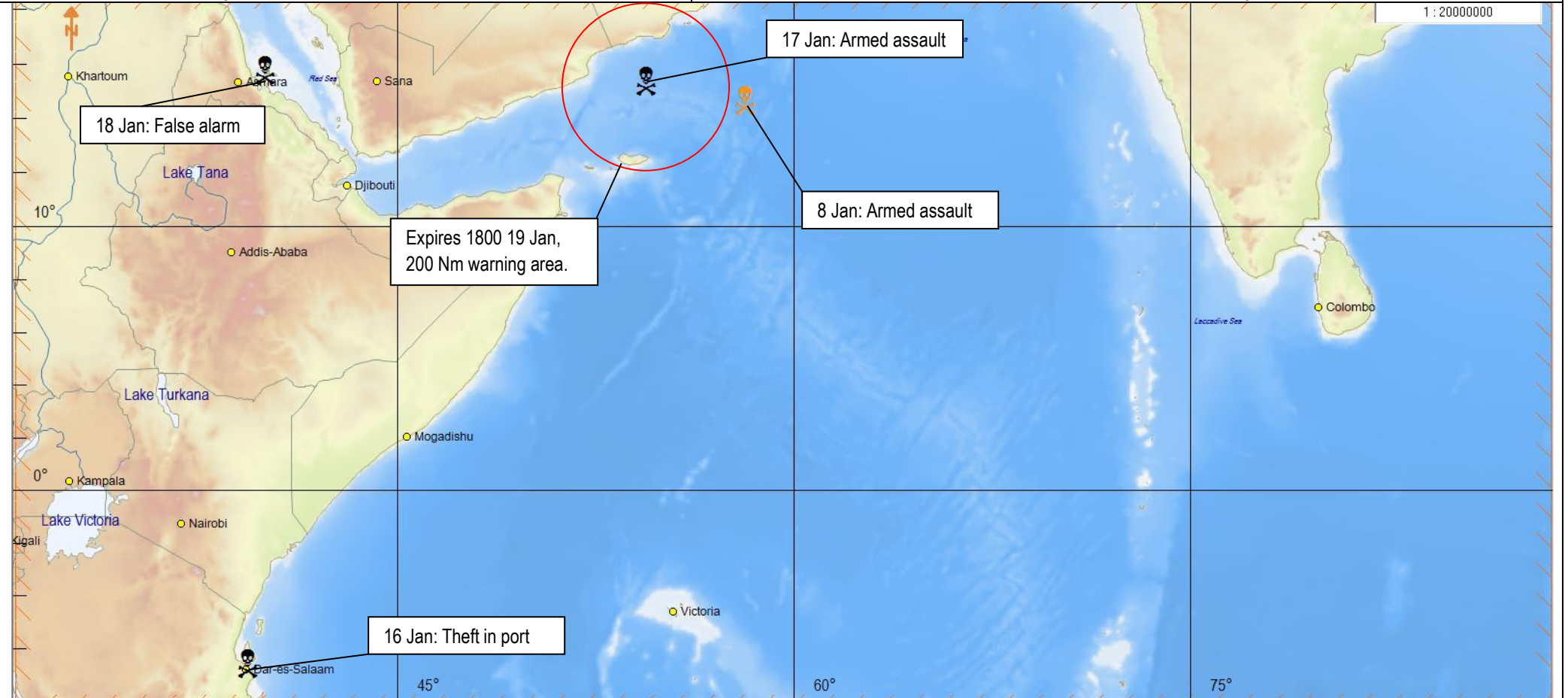

Map shows recorded incidents past 4 weeks. Red circles denote 200 Nm radius current warning area(s) as result of attacks or observations during last 48 hours.

LEGEND: **Black:** Incidents past 7 days regardless of type (see below). Intended to highlight recent attacks (or attempts thereof) and identifying high-risk areas. **Red:** Successful hijackings and/or kidnaps. **Yellow:** Armed assaults (attempted hijacks). **Blue:** Attempts in which there are no reports of firearms being used. **Green:** Suspicious approach or mothership/Pirate Action Group observation.

NOTE on mothership and Pirate Action Groups (PAGs): Virtually all incidents far off shore represents the risk of a mothership in the vicinity. (i) Red circle(s) on the map represent the most recent and thus accurate data. (ii) Black symbols with no red ring around them are between 3 and 7 days old and the position of the mothership cannot be ascertained with great accuracy any longer. (iii) The other coloured symbols are more than 7 days old. Continued presence of a mothership cannot be ascertained with this map for more info.)
